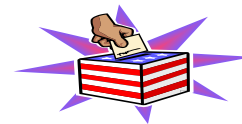
AUDITIONS FOR *DRINKING HABITS*



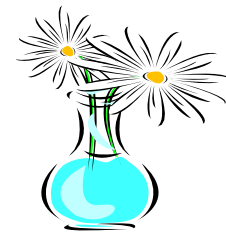
